

The total length of Mekong-river is 4,900km, originates in China's Qinghai province 源出青海省, the river's 2,198km length is inside China, 雲南省內 1,274km of it's length is within Yunnan province.

Within China, it is called "LanCang-river" 瀾滄江, outside China, it is known as the "Mekong-river" 湄公河.




# Beijing Arrival






Built at 1794 during Qing Dynasty, FengQing Stone-cave Temple has a glorious surrounding, and some rare species of flower trees, interesting histories...










From HuayXai we started our Mekong-river two-day boat ride... along the river much viewing while relaxing on the boat...

This **expedition** takes advantage of the good weather season for the intended spots that we will visit, from the capital city of **Xinjiang** - Urumqi, through some of the most interesting nature & cultures in western & southern parts of Xinjiang – a true Central Asia **region**... then by land cross into one of the unique Central Asian countries - Kyrgyzstan... fascinating!
